

MINUTES  
SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING  
CITY OF NICEVILLE, FLORIDA  
SEPTEMBER 19, 2013

The Niceville City Council met in special session at 6:00PM, September 19, 2013 in the Council Chambers, 208 N Partin Drive. All council members, except for Councilman Henkel, and the Mayor was present. Also present were City Manager Lannie Corbin; City Clerk Dan Doucet, the Library Director Sheila Bishop; Technology Chad Morris and a member of the press. Mayor Wise called the meeting to order at 6:00PM.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

Ordinance 13-09-05 - An ordinance of the City of Niceville, Florida levying the Ad Valorem Property Tax Millage Rate for municipal purposes on all taxable property within the City for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2013 and ending September 30, 2014 stating the percentage by which the millage to be levied exceeds the rolled-back rate; and providing for an effective date. (Third Reading)

Mr Doucet read ordinance 13-09-05 in it's entirety and stated the proposed millage rate of 3.70 is the recommended rate for FY-14. He stated the percentage by which this millage rate to be levied exceeds the rolled-back rate of 3.6345 (computed pursuant to Florida law) is 1.80%. Mr Doucet advised that the revenues received will be used to defray budgeted General Fund Expense. Councilman Rominger moved approval on third reading. Councilman Nodjomian seconded. No one spoke for or against. Mayor Wise asked for a roll call vote: Council Vote: Schaetzle-yes; Boudreaux-yes; Rominger-yes; Nodjomian yes. Motion passed.


Ordinance 13-09-06 - An ordinance adopting the final budget for the City of Niceville for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2013; an ordinance adopting and approving the appropriations set forth in said budget for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2013; and providing for an effective date. (Third Reading)

Mr Doucet read ordinance 13-09-06 by title. Councilwoman Boudreaux moved approval on third reading. Councilman Schaetzle seconded. No one spoke for or against. Council Vote: Schaetzle-yes; Boudreaux-yes; Nodjomian-yes; Rominger-yes. Motion passed.
