

MINUTES
SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING
CITY OF NICEVILLE, FLORIDA
SEPTEMBER 17, 2015

The Niceville City Council met in special session at 6:00 PM, September 17, 2015 in the Council Chambers, 208 N Partin Drive. All council members were present except for Councilman Rominger who participated via telephone conference, and the Mayor was present. Also present were City Manager Lannie Corbin; City Clerk Dan Doucet; Attorney Dixie Powell; Chief Popwell, Police Department; Chief Mayville, Fire Department; Sheila Bishop Library, Community Center and Children's Park; Chad Morris, Technology Department; and two visitors in the audience. Mayor Wise called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

Ordinance 15-09-01 - An ordinance of the City of Niceville, Florida levying the AD Valorem Property Tax millage rate for municipal purposes on all taxable property within the City for the Fiscal year beginning October 1, 2015 and ending September 30, 2016 stating the percentage by which the millage to be levied exceeds the rolled-back rate; and providing for an effective date. (Third Reading)

Mr Doucet read ordinance 15-09-01 in its entirety and stated the proposed millage rate of 3.70 is the recommended rate for FY-16. He stated the percentage by which this millage rate to be levied exceeds the rolled-back rate of 3.5714 (computed pursuant to Florida law) is 3.60%. Mr Doucet advised that the revenues received will be used to defray budgeted General Fund Expense. Councilman Henkel moved approval on final reading. Councilwoman Boudreaux seconded. No one spoke for or against. Mayor Wise asked for a roll call vote: Council Vote: Henkel-yes; Schaetzle-yes; Boudreaux-yes; Nodjomian-yes; Rominger-yes; Motion passed.

Ordinance 15-09-02- An ordinance adopting the final budget for the City of Niceville for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2015 an ordinance adopting and approving the appropriations set forth in said budget for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2015 and providing for an effective date. (Third Reading)

Mr Doucet read Ordinance 15-09-02 by title: Councilman Henkel moved approval on third reading. Councilman Nodjomian seconded. No one spoke for or against. Council Vote: Henkel-yes; Schaetzle-yes; Boudreaux-yes; Nodjomian-yes; Rominger-yes; Motion passed.

The meeting adjourned at 6:10 PM.
