

MINUTES
REGULAR YOUTH ADVISORY COUNCIL MEETING
CITY OF NICEVILLE, FLORIDA
MARCH 11, 2014

The Niceville Youth Advisory Council met in regular session at 6:00 PM, March 11, 2014 in the City of Niceville Council Chambers, 208 N Partin Drive. All members were present except for Taylor Anderson and Stella Kim. Also present was Youth Council Advisor, Councilman Nodjomain and City Clerk, Dan Doucet, a member of the press and visitors in the audience. Chairman William Adams offered the prayer and led the Pledge of Allegiance. The meeting was called to order by William Adams at 6:00 PM.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Regular Meeting, February 11, 2014

Chairman Adams requested approval of the February minutes. Jason Nodjomain moved approval. Caroline Schreck seconded. Council Vote: Schreck-yes; Adams-yes; Nodjomain-yes. Motion passed..

PUBLIC HEARINGS:

Old Business:

- Formation of a public Face Book page for the Youth Advisory Council for the purpose of getting the word out to other youth, school announcements- update. Chairman Adams stated the Face Book page was created last Wednesday, March 5th at [Facebook.com/cityofnicevilleyac](https://www.facebook.com/cityofnicevilleyac).
- Incorporating Youth Advisory Council with Niceville High School and spreading the word to students by before/after school announcements - Update. Chairman Adams stated the notice was drafted and delivered. Discussion followed.

SOAR:

- The drafting of a soar announcement for NHS home rooms - Update. Chairman Adams stated the update was submitted to school administration. Discussion followed.

New Business:

- Establishing a Service Project.

Youth Council members decided to organize a total of 3 initiatives (1) A jeans drive which would involve the collection of used jeans, to provide clothing for the poor. All members agreed to hold the collection shortly after spring break, and to place collection boxes at local schools and other locations around the community. In addition, they will publicize the event as much as possible


especially among fellow high school students who may have used jeans that they can contribute. (2) Caroline Schreck suggested a spring clean up be organized for mostly Public Parks. It was discussed and it was agreed to develop a plan regarding the project. (3) Another possible project would be to organize an art contest in which contestants would submit ideas for an inspirational mural. The winning student will then have the opportunity to actually paint their mural on a wall near the triangle. Discussion followed. Councilman Nodjoman recommended the Youth Advisory Council formulate a plan for each initiative.

There being no further discussion the meeting adjourned at 6:50 PM.
