

MINUTES
YOUTH ADVISORY COUNCIL MEETING
CITY OF NICEVILLE, FLORIDA
MAY 13, 2014

The Niceville Youth Advisory Council met in regular session at 6:00 PM, May 13, 2014 in the City of Niceville Council Chambers, 208 N Partin Drive. All members were present to include the youth Council Advisor, Councilman Nodjomian and City Clerk, Dan Doucet and visitors in the audience. Chairman Adams let the Pledge of Allegiance and called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.

Chairman Adams requested approval of the Regular Meeting Minutes on March 11, 2014, Special Meeting Minutes on April 1, 2014 and the Regular Meeting Minutes on April 8, 2014. Jason Nodjomian moved approval. Christopher Lighthouse seconded. Council Vote: Schreck-yes; Kim-yes; Adams-yes; Nodjomian-yes; Lighthouse-yes. Motion carried.

Status of Youth Advisory Council Project:

Jeans Drive - update

Councilman Nodjomian stated that the Youth Council received some very good press in the Front Page of the Local News. He felt that would generate far reaching interest to help may the project a success.

Everyone was in consensus to extend the Jeans drive until the Friday before Labor Day. Councilman Nodjomian stated the Youth Advisory Council has three planned projects being (1) the Jeans Drive (2) Painting the Wall, and (3) a Community Clean-up. He recommended to defer the painting of the wall and the community clean up project to a later date in an effort to focus on and compete the Jeans Drive Project first before moving on to another project.

Stella stated she was successful in obtaining 15 boxes for the project and they are outside in her vehicle. She asked if the City has an area to store the boxes before they are

delivered. Mr Doucet stated we may be able to store them in the room behind the stage. He stated the room is under the control of the Friends of the Library and we could coordinate with Sheila Bishop who will be here for the regular Council meeting tonight.

C.J. Lightfoot stated he has had some difficulty with contacting the right people to coordinate with on where to locate the boxes. He left messages and some have responded, however, not all of them have called him back. He stated that so far Niceville High School, the Library and the Utility Billing office in the City will support us. Sal Nodjomian stated he will ask his neighbor who is a an asst pastor at the Niceville Methodist Church for e-mail contact information. Discussion followed.

Stella stated the start date for the drive would be April 21st. She further stated that it would be important for William and Jason to deliver the boxes between the 16th and 18th of April to be in place before the drive start date. Discussion followed.

Mr Doucet stated that during our last meeting there was discussion about adding information on the water bill regarding the Jeans Drive. He stated we need the information a few days before prior to our billing date which is scheduled for the 25th of April. In addition, Mr Doucet stated he made contact with the Bay Beacon and they can publish our advertisement as a public announcement in the paper to support the project. He asked if someone would write a press release to be sent to him and he'll transmit it to the Beacon. Discussion followed.


