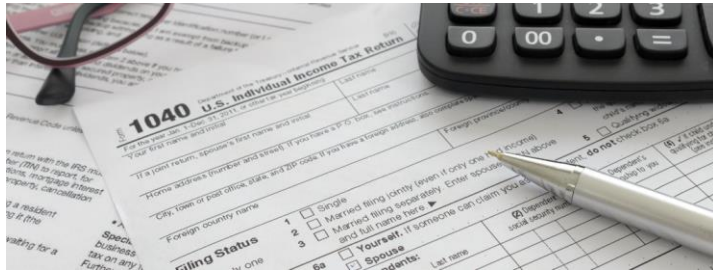


# Tax Information

## Tax Filing Assistance

Niceville Public Library partners with the Tax-Aide Program of the AARP Foundation to provide free tax preparation at the Library each year.

Tax preparation volunteers will help people with federal income tax returns **February 1, 2017 through April 18, 2017**. The schedule for tax assistance:

Wednesdays: 9 am – 1 pm

Fridays: 9 am – 5 pm

Saturdays: 9am – 1pm

## Tax Forms

All income tax materials can be downloaded from the [IRS website](http://www.irs.gov). They also can be ordered for delivery by mail.

Patrons can use library computers, Wi-Fi, and printers to download and print tax materials, and find helpful tax preparation resources. The cost to print is \$.10 per page.

Patrons may have limited (10 pages) forms printed for them free at the reference desk.

Due to Internal Revenue Service cutbacks, taxpayers seeking printed tax forms will find fewer of them in public libraries. Those forms and booklets that we do receive are located in the lobby.
