REGULAR YOUTH ADVISORY COUNCIL MEETING  
CITY OF NICEVILLE, FLORIDA  
JANUARY 13, 2026

The Youth Advisory Council met in regular session on January 13, 2026 in the Council Chambers, 208 N Partin Drive. Youth Advisory Council Executive members present were Logan Michel, Mary Colleen Johnson, and Grayson Schroeder; Addyson Eller and Eleanor Ballard were unable to attend. Also present were Youth Council Advisor, Councilman Tolbert; and Wendy Farmer, City Clerk. Youth Council Chairman Logan Michel presided over the meeting, led the Pledge of Allegiance, and called the meeting to order at 4:18 PM. There was one person in the audience.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Regular Meeting, December 9, 2025

Mr. Schroeder moved approval of the minutes, and Ms. Johnson seconded the motion. No one spoke for or against.

**Old Business:**

Update on projects progress.

Mr. Schroeder explained the timing did not work out for the Bed4Me fundraiser. He stated that he started over and will be doing a public safety event for children. Councilman Tolbert told him that the Council had an ordinance for e-bikes, micro-mobility devices on the agenda and the county is as well. They could do an advertising campaign or safety campaign in conjunction with that as one of the requirements will be helmets for those 16 and under. Discussion followed regarding working with the Public Information Officer and the Police Department. Mrs. Farmer told them they could obtain the packet the Council receives for their meetings on the website.

Ms. Johnson stated she had been trying to get ahold of someone at the Pavilion, but no date had been set yet. She also stated she had tried contacting the Autism Center but had not heard back from them. Councilman Tolbert reminded them that in the past they had done Valentine's Day cards for the Pavilion members as well if they are looking for a quick event.

Mr. Michel reached out to Plew Elementary and spoke with their Green Team regarding the recycling project. It looks like they will be able to go on a Friday at 1:30 PM and talk to the fifth graders. He thinks he could do a 10-to-15-minute presentation with other council members. Councilman Tolbert reminded him that Doug Rainer would be a good contact for assistance. Mr. Michel said he would contact Councilman Tolbert when the date was set.

**New Business:**

Youth Council Legislative Action Days (Tallahassee): January 27-28, 2026

They discussed which day most members could attend. It was decided they would attend the first day, January 27<sup>th</sup>. The deadline is January 14<sup>th</sup> so they were told to send Mrs. Farmer their final list by noon tomorrow. They were reminded to wear their shirts and nice slacks or skirts.
