The Niceville Public Library has display spaces available for individuals and organizations to display their art, crafts, or collections. The following guidelines should be followed when planning an exhibit or display.

1. A glass display table as well as floor and table top easels are available. The display case is locked when in use. The placement of the easels are at the discretion of the Library.
2. Unless a special schedule is needed, the exhibit will be up for one calendar month to allow for good public exposure. Please bring in your material and remove them promptly to maintain an orderly schedule. The Library will send a publicity notice to local papers, so please provide us with a brief biography and description of the collection.
3. The owner/artist is responsible for installing and dismantling the display.
4. The Library staff cannot sell items from the exhibit, but prices may be attached to items on business cards, or a price list may be left at the Circulation Desk.
5. If you are interested in providing a display, please complete the form below and submit it to the Reference Manager for approval and scheduling. Please plan on providing samples or a website of your work prior to approval.
6. Pieces of the exhibit may be switched out during your display dates or the entire exhibit can be changed within your display time period.
7. We currently have 10 large floor easels and 15 tabletop easels.
